Work Experience & Work Related Learning

Work Experience is a useful tool to develop the management skills of staff, to get fresh eyes on a project and provide that all important extra pair of hands. Placements provide a valuable insight into young people and are usually one or two weeks (or can be over an extended period) at no cost to the employer.

Work Related Learning activities help engage young people, enabling them to acquire the knowledge and skills employers seek from future employees. These activities include: Employer Talks, Mock Interviews, CV Workshops, Careers Events, Employer Led Assignments and Site Visits.

YC Hertfordshire works closely with schools and employers to provide these opportunities and we will actively support you through this simple process.

Supported Internships

As an employer you may wish to offer a Supported Internship. YC Hertfordshire can provide free support to set up an Internship of up to 9 months which will prepare a young person with Learning Difficulties and Disabilities (up to the age of 25) ready for employment. The aim is to convert placements into paid jobs, and therefore fulfilling a real business need and adding value.
